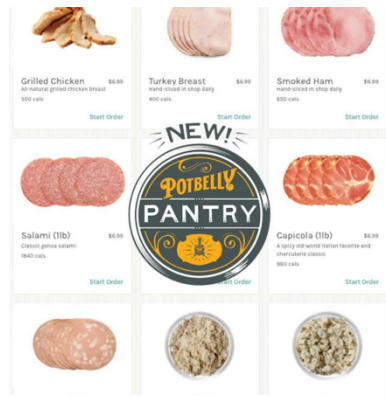


## Potbelly is selling its ingredients in bulk so you can make sandwiches at home

Amid the COVID-19 pandemic, restaurants and fast casual food joints were forced to close their dining areas to the public and pivot their businesses to carry-out only.

Starting Wednesday, Potbelly Sandwich Shops is upping its carry-out offering to include selling its ingredients in bulk to customers.

The sandwich chain's new Potbelly Pantry allows fans to go online to order its sliced deli meats and cheese along with famous hot peppers and breads in bulk amounts for pickup or delivery.

Potbelly's popular A Wreck sandwich is also available with proportioned sizes so you can make your own. You can also order chicken and tuna salads, flat breads, mini cookies and chips.

Sliced deli meats (salami, mortadella, capicola, pepperoni, smoked ham and turkey breast) are \$6.99 a pound and packaged in one-pound packages. Sliced cheeses are packaged in 10-ounce packages and \$4.49 each. Potbelly's signature bread is \$3.99 for a six-pack and flatbreads come 10 to a pack for \$3.99. A 16-ounce jar of hot peppers is \$6.95.

Orders can be made at Potbelly.com or through the Potbelly app for contactless curbside pickup or delivery at participating locations. Through Sunday, delivery is free.
